

Flower Field



FINISHED SIZE

Blanket measures 36" X 36"

MATERIALS

- DK, Light (3) weight yarn was used for the blanket pictured:
 - Baby Bee Sweet Delight (115g / 377yds per skein)
 - Baby Red (17 flowers) – 1 skein
 - Sunkisses (16 flowers) – 1 skein
 - Meema's Blue (16 flowers) – 1 skein
 - Froggy (Color A) – 1 skein
 - Angel (MC) – 3 skeins
 - Completed blanket: 440g / 16oz (approximately 1,442 yards total)
- Size G-6 (4.0mm) crochet hook
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE

With a G-hook and light (3) weight yarn, finished square motifs measure 5" across.

ABBREVIATIONS USED

sp = space	sc = single crochet
st(s) = stitch(es)	hdc = half double crochet
ch = chain	dc = double crochet
sl st = slip stitch	MC = Main Color

PATTERN NOTES

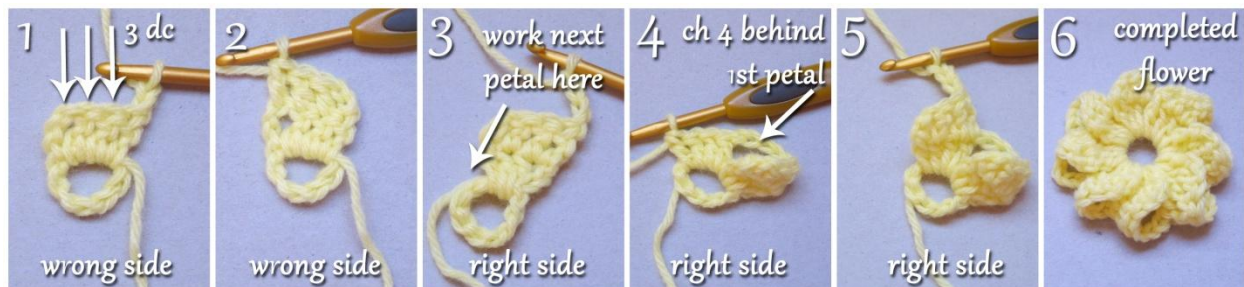
The blanket pictured has 49 squares motifs. If you want to mimic the colors and layout of the blanket shown, please see page 3 to view the entire blanket.

INSTRUCTIONS

FLOWER

With chosen color for flower, ch 8, sl st to form ring.

- Petal #1 [Figures 1 – 3]: ch 3 (counts as 1st dc), 3 dc into ring, ch 2, turn work (wrong side facing you), skip 1st dc, dc in next 2 dc, dc in top of beginning ch-3, ch 4, turn work (right side facing you)
- Petals #2 – 8 [Figures 4 – 6]: place the ch-4 *behind* the previously made petal, then work 4 dc into ring, ch 2, turn work (wrong side facing you), skip 1st dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 4, turn work (right side facing you); repeat for a total of 8 petals, then sl st join to top of ch-3 on 1st petal, fasten off.



SQUARE SHAPING AROUND FLOWER

- Round 1 (Color A, work into ch-4 spaces behind petals): insert hook into 1st ch-4 sp and pull up Color A, ch 3 (counts as 1st dc, here and throughout), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc)(into 1st ch-4 sp), *3 dc in next ch-4 sp, (3 dc, ch-2, 3 dc)(in next ch-4 sp), repeat from * around, end with 3 dc in last ch-4 sp, sl st join to top of beginning ch-3, sl st in next 2 dc, fasten off Color A
- Round 2 (MC): insert hook into 1st ch-2 sp and pull up MC, ch 3, (1 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)(in 1st ch-2 sp), *dc in next 9 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)(in ch-2 sp), repeat from * around, end with dc in last 9 dc, sl st join to top of beginning ch-3, sl st in next dc, sl st in ch-2 sp
- Round 3 (MC): ch 3, (1 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)(in 1st ch-2 sp), *dc in next 13 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)(in ch-2 sp), repeat from * around, end with dc in last 13 dc, sl st join to top of beginning ch-3, sl st in next dc, sl st in ch-2 sp
- Round 4 (MC): ch 3, (1 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)(in 1st ch-2 sp), *dc in next 17 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)(in ch-2 sp), repeat from * around, end with dc in last 17 dc, sl st join to top of beginning ch-3, sl st in next dc, sl st in ch-2 sp



To complete the blanket as pictured, fasten off at the end of Round 4 and weave in ends. To make larger squares, continue working additional rounds (directions are included on page 3). You may work as many rounds as you like.

OPTIONAL EXTRA ROUNDS

- Round 5 (MC): ch 3, (1 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)(in 1st ch-2 sp), *dc in next 21 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)(in ch-2 sp), repeat from * around, end with dc in last 21 dc, sl st join to top of beginning ch-3, sl st in next dc, sl st in ch-2 sp
- Round 6 (MC): ch 3, (1 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)(in 1st ch-2 sp), *dc in next 25 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)(in ch-2 sp), repeat from * around, end with dc in last 25 dc, sl st join to top of beginning ch-3, sl st in next dc, sl st in ch-2 sp
- Round 7 (MC): ch 3, (1 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)(in 1st ch-2 sp), *dc in next 29 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)(in ch-2 sp), repeat from * around, end with dc in last 29 dc, sl st join to top of beginning ch-3, sl st in next dc, sl st in ch-2 sp

JOINING MOTIFS

Position the squares as desired then join with your favorite joining method. Blanket pictured was joined with slip stitches on the backside. You could also whip stitch them together or any other method of your choosing. After joining, weave in ends and begin working the border.

BORDER

Insert hook into any stitch along the edge and pull up MC.

- Round 1: ch 1, sc in same st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, (sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st)(repeat around), sl st join to 1st sc, fasten off and weave in ends.
