

# Love the Winter

## Materials

2 different colored skeins of worsted weight yarn, 50-100 yards of each color, size US 8/5.0mm 16in/40cm circular needle, size US 8/5.0mm double pointed needles, tapestry needle

## Gauge

18 stitches and 20 rows = 4 inches in pattern

## Sizes

Baby (child, adult small, adult large)

13in (16in, 18.5in, 21in)

33cm (40cm, 47cm, 53cm)

## Abbreviations

k - knit

p - purl

k2tog - knit two together

## Pattern

### Cast on (worked in color A)

Cast on 60 (72, 84, 96) stitches onto needle. For 13in and 16in sizes work whole hat on double pointed needles. For 18.5in and 21in hat cast onto circular needle. Join in the round being careful not to twist.

### Ribbing (worked in color A)

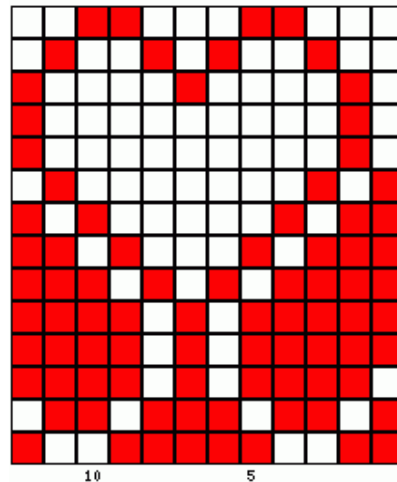
\*k2, p2\* repeat until end of round for a total of 4 (6, 8, 10) rounds

### Solid rounds of color A

Knit 3 (6, 10, 13) rounds

### Hearts

Next 14 rounds knit from chart

### Solid rounds of color B

Knit 3 (6, 10, 13) rounds

### Decreases for 13 in and 16 in size (worked in color B)

Rnd 1: \*k10, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 2: \*k9, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 3: \*k8, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 4: \*k7, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 5: \*k6, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 6: \*k5, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 7: \*k4, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 8: \*k3, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 9: \*k2, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 10: \*k1, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 11: \*k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Cut yarn and pull through remaining loops. Weave in ends.

### Decreases for 18.5 in and 21 in size (worked in color B)

Rnd 1: \*k10, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 2: knit around

Rnd 3: \*k9, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 4: knit around

Rnd 5: \*k8, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Transfer onto double pointed needles

Rnd 6: knit around

Rnd 7: \*k7, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 8: knit around

Rnd 9: \*k6, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 10: knit around

Rnd 11: \*k5, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 12: knit around

Rnd 13: \*k4, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 14: knit around

Rnd 15: \*k3, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 16: \*k2, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 16: \*k1, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Rnd 19: \*k2tog\* for entire round

Rnd 20: \*k1, k2tog\* repeat until end of round

Cut yarn and pull through remaining loops. Weave in ends.
